



Haiti DX Operations

This presentation will be a composite look at many operations from Haiti over the past several years. It will include interesting slides and video clips.

For many years from about 1996-2002 amateur radio operations from Haiti were very limited. Thanks to facilities and the cooperation of the Northwest Haiti Christian Mission, and support from Jean-Robert-HH2JR and the Radio Club of Haiti, several hams have been able to obtain licenses and help keep Haiti off the most wanted lists.

Jan has made eight two-week mission trips to Haiti during which he has been able to operate from the mission. Several hams including Bill-N2WB, Bill-W4WX, Bob-K9MDO, Koh-JA1ADT (K2AC), and Don-AF4Z have made trips with Jan to the mission.

Jan has 31,605 contacts in his personal log from his trips. Don and others have made over 24,000 contacts for a total of over 55K contacts.
